Come to the Table is our theme for Advent. At the table, Jesus meets us with grace, forgiveness, and restoration. He resets us, weekly, with a grace that only God can offer. It is so powerful to approach the table preparing to receive Christ and all He offers.

That said: One of the fun things in Advent is to recognize there is not a "set" series of themes. Our series tracks the traditional Advent themes of Hope, Faith, Joy, and Peace (for example, that is how it's laid out from the Lutheran Concordia Publishing House), while others list the themes slightly differently. A quick google search will show them in different orders or terms (e.g., some insert the theme of "love" rather than "faith," and use that as the last Sunday in Advent. Some use blue candles (like we're using this year), while others use purple or white candles.

When I first became a pastor, this was a bit confusing. The idea that there wasn't a central, agreed upon, set of Advent themes was strange. But it points to something bigger: within the Christian community, we don't always practice our faith exactly the same way!

When it comes to Scripture, we don't have that wiggle room of course. We don't get to pick and choose. But when it comes to how we live it out, practices vary. When celebrating the birth, life, and resurrection of Christ, we know that it's done in a variety of ways around the world. Same Christ but different worship styles, candle colors, lay outs of churches and more.

This year, we will focus on coming to the table for Hope, Faith, Joy, and Peace. We will celebrate the presence of Christ when He came the first time, as He continues to be present with us, and as we prepare for His return.

**Secretary's Report:** Minutes from the September meeting were emailed to all in attendance, hard copies were available. Chris made a motion to approve the minutes and Scott seconded. Motion carried.

**Treasurer's Report:** Amy presented the Treasurer's report. There was a large increase in giving this month and we were able to stay positive in the monthly snapshot of the budget, though we have a way to go before we can pay

ourselves back the money we borrowed from our building fund. Wes made a motion to approve the report and Chris seconded. Motion carried.

### Old Business:

#### Facilities and Grounds

- a. Kevin Kroening was hired to fill the facilities position. Kevin shared that he and Rich had a hand off meeting on the position as well as to help get to know the building.
- b. It was decided to contract with Anderson Excavating for snow removal this winter again, a big reason for this is to (cont.)

make sure that the parking lot is cleared out for PCC drop off in the morning.

2. Peace Child Care – The flooring where the kids eat is getting switched from carpet to LVP for easier maintenance and longevity in the space
3. Facility Assessment – Cole to finish prepping the paperwork so that it can be completed
4. Fuel Pre-buy – Cole is going to reach out to Lakes Gas for a pre buy contract
5. Cemetery Stone Leveling – will talk to Willy in the spring
6. Worship Director – Wes is going to follow up with Laura about her IRA match
7. Bus and Vehicle Insurance – trustees decided to keep the truck covered with Liability insurance only. On the bus, we will get comprehensive coverage including tow and rental coverage with a \$500 deductible

**New Business:**

1. Budget
  - a. We will meet on November 3<sup>rd</sup> at 9:15 to discuss salaries for the 2025 budget so that Amy has time to update the budget.

2. Coffee Shop – YOF is looking at starting a coffee shop run by the kids. They will be trying for the first time at trunk or treat.
3. Cole asked if there was any objection to getting bubble covers for the fire alarm pull stations to prevent any accidental pulls with how many young kids are in the church. Everyone was in agreement that this would be a good idea.
4. Due to the good problem of running low on space for all the things going on at our church, people are going through storage and sorting things that have not been used in a long time. The trustees recommended setting the items out for two weeks before disposing of them so that if anyone wants them they have an opportunity to take them.

**Old Business:**

8. Facilities Assessment
  - a. Cole to send the template to Amy for her to print out and give to Kevin to start going through. We know there are going to be things that he will not be able to answer but we thought it would be a good way to start gathering info and for Kevin to get to know the building and systems.
  - b. Kevin is waiting for Missi to pick paint colors for him to begin painting Sunday school rooms.

9. Peace Child Care – Jim and Bill came to the meeting; they requested that we think about having a trustee permanently added to the PCC board. 12. Budget – Most of the meeting was spent discussing the 2025 budget. Amy provided a 3-year comparison and average budget to help show trends. Cristy provided an updated percentage sheet to show to date fund use vs budget. With the salary component set, we discussed some of the different groups' budgets and what some of the drivers were for changes over the past years. One section that we plan on bringing to Council for discussion was the Mission section and the way the percentages were broken down. With the generous giving from church members, (cont.)

the percentage used to cover the cost of Feed My Starving Children is roughly 50% over what the actual cost is. The question is do we want to leave it this way or adjust the percentages among the different missions.

- a. We have two positions open at the end of the year. Wes said that he would stay on for another term, we will need to talk to Dick and

see if he wants to stay on or if we need to find someone to fill his position.

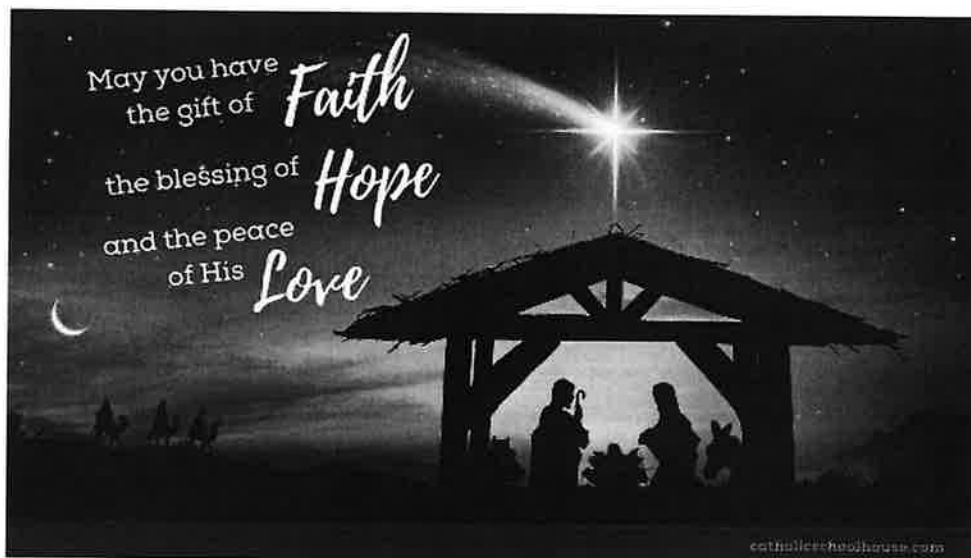
